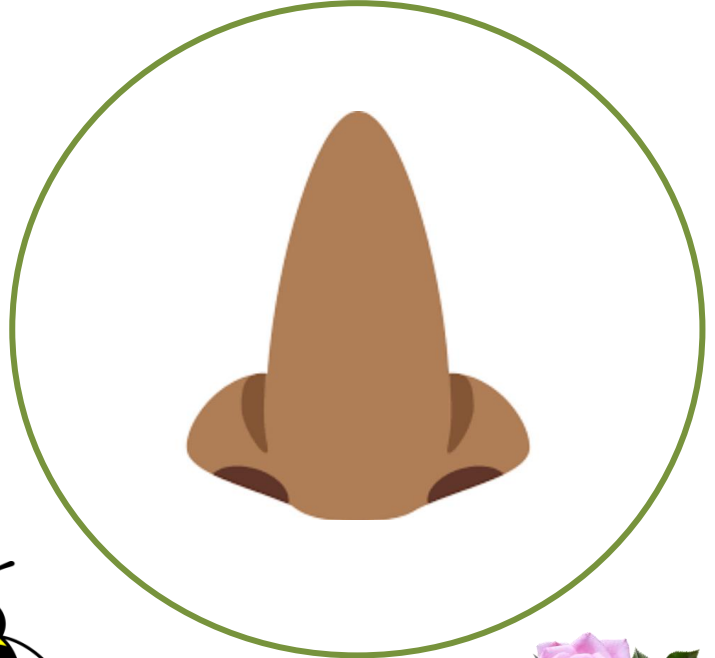

There are no such things as seagulls! There are Common Gulls and Herring Gulls, who we see every day. They are a globally threatened species.

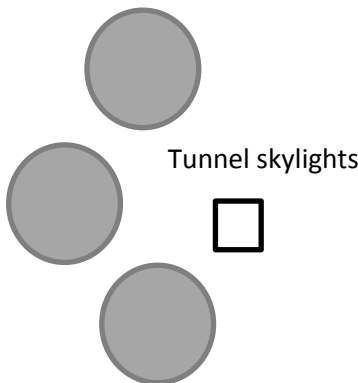

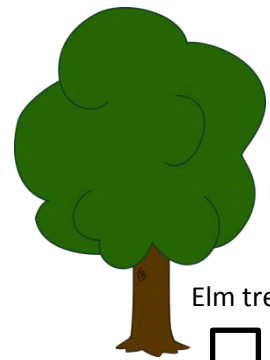

Underground tunnels were used by King George IV to visit the riding school and stables, now better known as Brighton Dome.




Elm trees
