Antonin Careme was one of the first “celebrity” chefs. Working for Napoleon, the Tzar of Russia, and the Prince Regent here at the Royal Pavilion, he prepared lavish feasts such as “Les petits vol-au-vonts a la nesle” a grand affair with Chicken, Lobster and Truffles. Our tearoom doesn’t quite offer such opulent feasts, but there’s King size vol- au-vents along with substantial sandwiches, homemade soups & savouries available from 11am – 3pm daily

The Royal Pavilion Tearoom has a colourful history and appears to have seen more than its fair share of intrigue and secrecy.

In the time of George IV, the rooms were used by top courtiers and intimates of the King. The room that is now the kitchen was the bedroom of George’s Private Secretary, Sir William Knighton. Sir William seems to have been a shady character, a slightly sinister Mr Fixit whose role was to get the King out of his endless scrapes.

The main Tearoom was originally two rooms, and it seems likely that these were occupied by the King’s last mistress, Lady Conyngham. What once was her dressing room has a ‘secret’ staircase, which communicates directly with the King’s bedroom on the floor below. You may have been able to see the door at the foot of the staircase to the right of George’s bed.

After George IV’s death in 1830, the rooms were occupied from 1832 by Queen Adelaide, wife of William IV. When Queen Victoria came to the throne in 1837, the rooms were occupied by her mother, the Duchess of Kent, and her Ladies-in-Waiting.

After the sale of the Royal Pavilion to the town in 1850, the rooms were considerably altered for use as a town museum.

The Tearoom is now open daily. The stunning balcony with views across Pavilion Gardens to the Museum, Dome and Corn Exchange is open most of the summer (weather permitting!).
