# The Old Courtroom

Hidden away in the centre of Brighton's bustling creative hub is the Old Courtroom. Part of Brighton's original Victorian courthouse, the Old Courtroom mixes historic charm with modern technology. The space is fitted with a 152 seat retractable raked seating stand, allowing the room to be arranged in different layouts. A state-of-the-art projector and built in sound system make this the perfect space for lectures, conferences and larger meetings. With the seating retracted, the large open floorplan is perfect for trade shows and standing events.

Located opposite the Royal Pavilion Estate, the Old Courtroom is ideal for a daytime conference or lecture, followed by a dinner at the Royal Pavilion or Brighton Museum & Art Gallery, a mere 3 minute walk away.
